The Government of the Philippines (GOP) has received a loan from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development - World Bank (IBRD-WB), amounting to FIVE HUNDRED ONE MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (US\$501,250,000) for the purpose of financing the 'Philippine Rural Development Project (PRDP)' and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this loan to payments for the hiring of interested applicants to fill up the vacant position of One (1) RURAL INFRA ENGINEER.

The PRDP is a six-year (2013-2018) initiative of the government envisioned to increase farm and fishery productivity and incomes in target areas in all 16 regions of the country. The program seeks to achieve this objective by

improving access of farmers and other industry players to a strategic network of infrastructure, market information and support services. Specific investments and interventions are to be implemented under four central components of the program, namely: 1) Investments for AFMP Planning at the Local and National Levels (I-PLAN); 2) Intensified Building Up of Infrastructure and Logistics for Development (I-BUILD); 3) Investments for Rural Enterprises and Agricultural and Fisheries Productivity (I-REAP); and 4) Implementation Support to PRDP (I-SUPPORT).

Scope of Work

Specifically, the tasks of the I-BUILD Rural Infra Engineer will include but not limited to the following:

- Assists the I-BUILD Component Head in assessment, monitoring and evaluation of PRDP Projects;
- Assist the I-BUILD Component in the Conduct of Review and evaluation of Project Documents consistent with the PRDP required processes and systems;
- Conducts random SP inspection of ongoing SPs, safeguards and fiduciary audit in aid of systems/policy enhancement in subproject implementation;
- Assists in the maintenance of Mindanao Cluster data base, consolidation of progress reports and analysis of data to hasten management decision making; and,
- Performs other task as maybe assigned by the RPCO I-BUILD Component Head.

- Must be a Licensed Agricultural/Civil Engineer.

- Minimum of three (3) years working experience in performing similar and related works; and,
- At least 2 years in foreign-assisted projects (FAPs) implemented by LGUs.
